He is responsible for all Renewable Power Projects other than Government Schemes, regulatory and policy issues related to the sector and other related technical activities of the Company. He is also responsible for transmission system planning, system stability due to RE integration and transmission related coordination for all Renewable Power Projects. He will also ensure effective utilization of resources available in the company through consultancy services and Joint Ventures in domestic and international markets.
